JUSTICE AND PEACE

Community Meal TODAY. The Reedsburg Community Meal will be held Sunday, August 25th, 4:00 pm – 6:00 pm, at St. John's Lutheran Church. It is being sponsored by our Justice and Peace Group in support of local agriculture. Everyone is invited to attend. It's a nice opportunity for fellowship, along with a delicious meal made from fresh local foods.

National Interest: In mid-August, U.S. Bishops (USCCB) opposed a Department of Homeland Security ruling that would deny some public benefits to immigrants. "This rule will undermine family unity and lead many lawful immigrants to forgo vital assistance, including enrollment in nutrition, housing, and medical programs. Families already in the U.S. will be faced with deciding whether to access critical assistance programs for which they qualify, knowing that in doing so they could jeopardize their ability to stay here with their loved ones. Ultimately, we believe that this rule is in tension with the dignity of the person and the common good that all of us are called to support."

Green Tip of the Week: Take your own reusable water bottle (preferably made of stainless steel) with you instead of using commercially bottled water. The plastic that houses bottled water takes lots of energy to produce, is made of chemicals that can leach into your drink under certain conditions, and requires an efficient recycling plan for the jettisoned bottle.
