Our entrance hymn this week, “Creator Spirit By Whose Aid”, has roots that go back as far as 847! The original author was Rabanus Maurus who was born Hrabanus Magnentius Maurus and educated under Alcuin of York, an English scholar and teacher. Alcuin is said to have given Rabanus the surname, Maurus, after the saint of that name.

Who is Saint Maurus, you ask? St. Maurus (Mauer) was born in Rome and placed under the care of St. Benedict at age 12 to be educated in piety and learning. After he was grown, St. Benedict selected him to be coadjutor in the government of monastery. One day while attempting to draw water St. Maurus’s fellow disciple, St. Placid, fell into the lake and was swept away by the current. Maurus is said to have been sent by St. Benedict to the lake where he received the Holy Father’s blessing, walked upon the waters and dragged Placid out by the hair without sinking himself.

St. Maurus was favored by God with the gift of miracles.

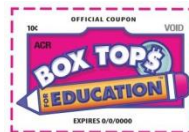

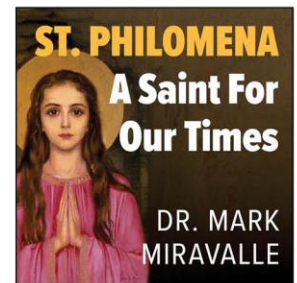
