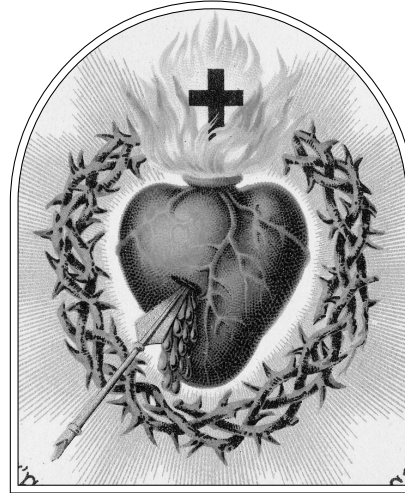

## *From the Parochial Administrator* of PASTORATE 7

*Dear Parishioners:*

I hope your Lent is going well. Hopefully we are benefitting from the blessings of our Lenten discipline. Regardless of what your Lenten devotion is, my prayer is that it draws us closer to Christ, aids us in our service of God and neighbor, and brings us closer to our faith family.



We have made our submission with the other parishes for the new name for our Pastorate. The Bishop will make a final decision and announce his selections to the parishes. I am hoping that this might be before Easter, but it could be after Easter. Once I have any news in this regard, I will announce it to all. It bears repeating that the names of our current church buildings will not be changed. We will however get a new name for our new parish that will replace "Pastorate 7".

The Transition Team and sub-committee are up and running, and have met twice. They will be reaching out to the parish and school staff, and unique volunteers of the parish to help gather needed data. The group meeting will rotate to the parishes in our Pastorate so they can have a good experience of each campus. I will keep you informed as we move along this process.

Finally, our priests' team and I met to plan our 2024 Holy Week and Easter Sunday schedule for our pastorate. In scheduling, we considered our goal to combine when necessary, and still have events done at our campuses. ## ARE WE DOING THE WORK OF GOD?

One of the difficult jobs facing priests and council members is the task of knowing the needs of the parish and finding a way to pay for it. Some have suggested that it sometimes leads to what they term "The crisis of belief". A great part of running a parish for me is realizing that I am doing the work of God. Hence a belief in God's providential care becomes integral in my ministry. While some might prefer the question, "What can we do?", I prefer to ask, What does God want us to accomplish? As one author puts it, **"Anytime that God leads you to do something that has God-sized dimensions, you will face a crisis of belief. When you face a crisis of belief, what you do next reveals what you really believe about God."**

As the book of Hebrews tells us: *"Without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that He exists, and He rewards those who earnestly seek him."* (Hebrews 11:6)

**Christ** has no body now but yours, no hands, no feet on earth but yours.

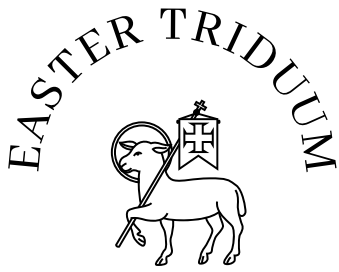

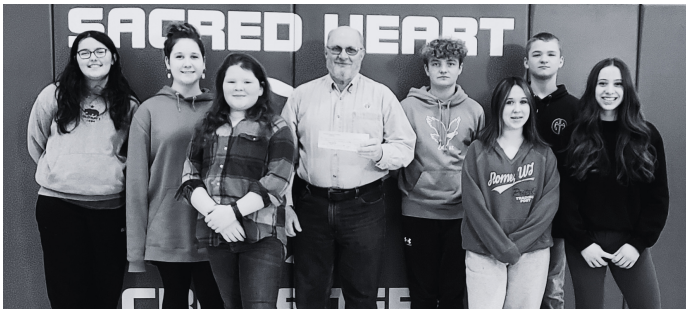

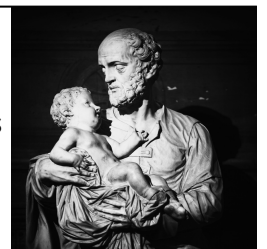
